FREEMAN PINCKNEY GALPIN: 1-104

In June of 1844 Philo sold to Freeman P. the 70 acres described as the E 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 9 except 10 acres on the North end. He charged him \$900, less than half of what he paid for it in 1840. On October 9, 1845 Freeman Pinckney Galpin, at the age of 20, married Almira D. Pray, the daughter of a neighbor and family friend Esek and Sally Pray. Genealogy of the Galpin Family compiled 1899 states that what is now "the

shop" was built as Freeman P. Galpin's home in 1845. Present frame house was erected in 1858; remodeled, 1874. In 1851 Philo sold to Freeman P. 51+ acres described as the E 30 rods in width of the West 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 9, 1 1/2 acres laying in the NE corner of the remaining land of above, and the East 20 rods off the East side of the NW 1/4 of Sec 17. The two parcels in Sec 9 included the frontage along Plymouth Rd. where Freeman P. built his homes. In February of 1852 Frederick Townsend sold to Almira 19 acres on the north side of Plymouth Rd directly across from their home for \$152. It is described as all that part of the W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 9 South of the center of the channel of the small creek or stream of water crossing said lot.

Philo E. was born from these parents on Oct. 2, 1847. Morris F. born June 24, 1849, and Franklin P., born Mar. 17, 1853 followed him. Almira died on April 20, 1853, I assume from complications of childbirth. The 1850 census shows that three other individuals were living with Freeman and Almira. I cannot make out the names, but they were 21 and 13-year-old males, and a 19-year-old female.

Freeman was now 28 years old, the father of three young children, a widower; a community minded person, and an important part of a large farm. Those had to be difficult days for both Freeman and the Galpin family. As was common in those days he had but little choice but to find another mate. On October 20, 1853 he married nineteen year old Mary E. Ruthruff who was the daughter of Samuel and Susannah Frain Ruthruff. (See attachment Nine p87) Ida May was born on May 20, 1856 from these parents. She was followed by William, born February 14, 1859; Ella born July 26, 1861 and died Sept 10, 1864; Eliza Jane, born March 15. 1865; Linus, born April 1, 1869; Luella, born Dec. 14, 1874, Minnie, born May 8, 1877; and Ella May, born Jan. 30, 1882. . The 1860 census shows a Harriet(?) Galpin, age 24, and a Sarah Galpin, age 15 living with Mary and Freeman. Additionally, a (?) Smith, age 27 and a Nathan Munger, age 22 were living in the house and working as farm help. Between 1863 and 1867 Freeman bought 160 additional acres of land in Superior Twp. at three different sites.

Freeman served as a Township Clerk from 1857-59. He served as the Township Supervisor from 1873-80, and as such was a member of the County Board of Supervisors. He was an elected trustee of an organization that undertook the task of building the Dixboro Methodist Church in 1858 at a cost of about \$2,200. He served as a trustee of the Church for the rest of his life.

Freeman P. was a little over six feet tall and slight of build. The horse barn was located behind the original house on his farm and had a large double door that faced the road. On an August day in 1899 Freeman was riding on a wagon that was higher than the one he usually used. He had taken a load of animals to market. Freeman either forgot or did not have time to duck and struck the beam above the door as the horses ran in. He was crushed between the beam and the rack on the wagon, and was seriously injured. Grace Judson quotes Minnie as saying that the injury to his chest was so painful that he could not bear to be picked up by his arms or shoulders. They had to lift him by his feet and his hair.

Another version of the story was written by William Freeman Galpin as told to him by his father Reverend William Galpin. This paper was given to me by Jeanne Thomas who is the daughter of William Freeman Galpin. "My father, the Rev. William Galpin, was born February 14, 1859 on a farm in Superior Township, Washtenaw county, Michigan. He was the fifth child of Freeman Pinckney Galpin born at Rush, New York, July 15, 1825 and died at his home in Superior Township, August 15, 1899, as the result of an odd accident. It seems that three or four days before his death he drove into Ann Arbor, Michigan with his oldest son, Philo E. Galpin, to sell some produce but especially to meet my two brothers, George 16 and Harris 10, who had left Elkhart Indiana to spend a few weeks with their grandfather on the farm. On returning with my brothers late in the afternoon they ran into a severe thunder storm and when they reached the barn my grandfather, in spite of his son's desire to have him get down from a wagon and hurry into the house, insisted upon driving into the barn with Philo and my brothers. Now, as was common at the time, the entrance to the barn was reached by rather sharp incline that ran from the ground level to what was called the barn floor; below was the basement for housing the horses and cattle. In order to take the incline it was customary to speed up the horses who with a dash swept into the barn. On this occasion, my grandfather thinking solely of the horses and not wishing to keep them out in the rain any longer than was necessary, urged Philo to drive on and this he did. As they reached the top of the incline, my grandfather and uncle both bent forward to avoid hitting the top beam of the door way, but unfortunately my grandfather did not bend forward far enough and was caught and crushed by the combined pressure of the beam and the pull of the horses. As soon as was possible, he was taken into the house and put to bed and some one sent post haste for a doctor at nearby Dixboro, a small country village two miles away where my uncle Morris lived." His injuries proved fatal and he died on August 15, some five months after the death of his wife, Mary.

Quoting from attachment six, " The writer of this obituary tells us that "although he clung to what he considered right with considerable tenacity, for the feelings of others, and would do almost anything to promote harmony and good will. Often did he say, even when he knew that someone was making an unjust claim upon him, "Well, we had better bear a wrong, than do one ourselves", and would act accordingly. He had been a trustee of the Dixboro Church ever since it was built. As such there has been no one person who has done more for the permanent good of the society than he has. He was not a man who was noted for his marked spirituality (i.e. he was not of the shouting, holiness type, as many of the early Methodists), but one who was nevertheless, a possessor of rich experiences in the things of God. He believed in living a life that would constantly show to men that the Lord had saved him from a life of sin. His home was a model one. There are hundreds who will say, "He was my Friend. " F.P. Galpin was unquestionably for most of 42 years one of the strongest and most worthy leaders of Dixboro Church. He died August 15, 1899. The respect which was rightfully his, was shown by the assemblage of over 300 people at his funeral. " Freeman P. was buried in the Pray Cemetery next to his two wives.

The sparks dropped down into the dry hay and the barn was beyond saving in the time that it took to run out there. Nate pulled the hay wagon and hay loader off the barn floor by hand, and released the cattle in the basement. The closest fire department was Salem, which was ten miles away.
